Send greeting: Whereas Jackson Elijah, Stacy James and others on or about the 18th day of September 1880 exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid against Anthony McKinney, Alex McKinney and others demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 12 day of November 1880 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the title to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be vested in Jackson Elijah absolutely, and that a deed be made to him to the same by the Master of said Court on his paying one half of the costs and expenses of partitioning the real estate described in said complaint. Wood and others and containing eight acres more or less, Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurtenant and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of all the parties to the cause aforesaid and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them. To Have and to Hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Jackson Elijah his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof I the said S. J.
