(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. C. Anderson all those two tracts of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, in parts of Laurel Creek, being in the tract described as follows beginning at a stone on the state line between the Rock & S. Barney Austin and Jackson's line, thence N 28 E 10 chs to a stake in the road side of a branch, thence S 18 1/2 E 10 chs to a stake in the road side of a branch, thence S 62 1/2 17.85 chs to stake in said Barney Austin's line, thence N 28 E 10 chs to the beginning corner. Containing eighteen & one half acres more or less.
