GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. T. West all that certain piece of

land and tract of land in Grove Township in the County of Greenville the State
aforesaid on both sides of a branch of Reedy Fork Creek, having the follow-
ing lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at a black gum tree in the Road
S. W. Latimer's line running thence with Latimer's line N 41 E 19.5 ft. to a stone & J. M.
Blakely's line, thence S 26 E 5.60 to a stone & one, thence S 26 E 12.50 to a burnt gum, thence
N 16 E 27.50 to a stone & one, thence N 49 E 10.40 to a stone & one, to or near the road;
