Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by J Henry Ware of the County of Greenville (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J Leah Alexander all and singular my undivided one third interest in all those two certain pieces and tracts of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid each containing ten acres more or less, and having the following lines, meters and bounds to wit: all that piece parcel of land on the East side of the White Horse Road adjoining lands of Henry Ware and others on small branch of Long Branch of Sandy River beginning at a stone 34 m on White Horse Road and running thence said Henry Ware line N 56 E 13.32 to a post 20 1/2 m on old Cleveland and Davines line thence with said last named line N 42 1/2 W 8.22 to a stone 34 m thence S 56 W 11.50 to a stone 34 m on Road thence said road to the beginning, also all that certain other piece of land and tract of land adjoining the above Henry Ware and others beginning at a stone 34 m on the White Horse Road and running thence N 20 E 11.50 to a stone 34 m on said line thence with said line N 42 1/2 W 8.22 to a stone 34 m thence S 56 W 11.60 to a stone on said W Horse Road thence with said road to the beginning being same tract of land conveyed to Richard Alexander by a Deed by deed of Jan 7, 1899 and June 3 1883 respectively, recorded in Book 1424-144 R.M.C.
