GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jas Williams all that piece

parcel or part of land situate lying and being in the State and County  
of South Carolina about twelve miles from Greenville S. D. S. on waters of Enore  
bounded on the north by Simpson Bishop (see Gilbeath Morgan Brown and others.  
It being part of a tract conveyed to me by Mrs Fiddie Bowling in a deed bearing  
date March 11<sup>th</sup>, 1877. It contains forty two and one tenth acres (42 1/10 acs).  
The same more or less and runs as follows: Beginning a stone corner of  
the mill race and runs thence N 88 E 2.10 to a stone, thence E 2 E 7.90 to a stone  
in the center of the mill race, thence along said Road N 88 E 24.60 to bend in the road  
thence N 88 E 23.40 to bend, thence S 76 E 6.30 to White O. then N 83 E 3.10 to a stone, thence
