And we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, Executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Joseph A. Galley his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs, or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
