Know all men by these
presents. That I William C Hawkins of Greenville
County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to me
in hand paid by Margaret Brumell of Greenville
County in the State aforesaid have granted ba-
gained sold and released and by these presents
do grant and bargain sell and release unto the said
Margaret Brumell a certain tract piece or parcel
of land in the county and State aforesaid
in both sides of Beaverdam Creek being a part
of a tract of land surveyed to me by the heirs
of Josiah Burton deceased. And begins and
runs as follows. Beginning at a Rock on
W C Goodwin's line East of W C Goodwin's
Black Gum corner and runs N.W. chain to
a large Pine on the ridge or a little beyond the top
said ridge a spur of the main spur from Duff Mountain
thereon in a straight line to a small Branch
on the left hand side of the branch as you go down
from the top of the ridge. Then down the meanderings
of said branch to Beaverdam Creek which branch
runs into Beaverdam Creek but a little way
