 Saluda River and containing One hundred
 and eighty seven and a half Acres more or less
 Together with all and singular the rights mem-
 bers hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever
 to the said Tract of land belonging or in anywise
 appertaining, and the reverses and remainders
 unto, issues and profits thereof, And also all the
 estate right title interest lower possession prop-
 erty benefit claim and demand whatsoever
 both at law and in Equity of the said J. Latham
 and of all the parties to the said suit and of
 all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof, by law or under
 them or either of them. I have and to hold
 the said Tract of land with its hereditaments
 privileges and appurtenances unto the said
