Now therefore, Know all men by these Presents: That I, Grayson M. Wasse, of the City of Denver, in the State of Colorado, in consideration of the premium and also in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Edith M. Wasse of the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said Edith M. Wasse, (and her singular heirs, assigns, interest and estate, of, in and to all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, on the South-East corner of College and Dorris streets, and having the following lines, meters and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on College street, 261 feet and 10 inches from main street, and running thence, North 63 West, along the North side of College street to its intersection with Dorris street, thence along the East side of Dorris street to its intersection with a street 44 feet wide, thence along the South side of the last named street to a point on the same, on the line
