I, Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff of Greenville County, and State aforesaid, send greeting:
Whereas, by writ of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the County of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested the 10th day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety two at the suit of the Greenville Coffee Company against Sanders Burns, Thomas Burns, Anna Custer and Harriett Johnson as heirs at law of Abner Burns, deceased, to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of the Defendants above mentioned to pay the sum of sixty eight ^{207.00} Dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Defendants above mentioned (all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing one half acre, more or less, situate and being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in City of Greenville, on Millers Street, adjoining lands of A.
