Whereas, the County Commissioners, in and for the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, by an Act of the Legislature of said State, approved the 24th day of December A.D. 1890, are "authorized, empowered and required to sell and convey in fee simple a portion of the jail lot in Greenville City," for purposes therein recited; and, whereas, said County Commissioners for the better definition of said quantity have had one hundred and fifty (150) feet of said lot, situate on the South side of Broad Street, to the East of the property of George Heldman and lying between said property and that portion of the jail lot on which the new jail now stands, surveyed and cut up into six lots of twenty five (25) feet front, each, and numbered from two (2) to seven (7) inclusive, on a plat made by J. M. Saitlum, D.S., on the 21st day of May A.D. 1891, and recorded as hereinafter stated; and whereas, said lots, after due notice, were exposed to sale at Public outcry, in front of the County House door, on Saturday in June A.D. 1891, and Eben D. Barr became the purchaser of lot number six at the sum of four hundred and seventy (470⁰⁰) dollars, being at
