Barr, all that certain piece or lot of land situated lying and being in the City of Greeneville, County and State aforesaid; Beginning on the South side of Broad Street at an ~~iron~~ iron pin in the North East corner of lot No. 7 of Plat herein referred to and running thence with the line of said lot S. 20. W. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40 E. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20 E. 110 feet to Broad Street; thence with said N. 40 E. 25 feet to the beginning corner; and being a part of the original jail lot and known as Lot number six on Plat made by J. M. Southern, &c., on the 21st day of May A.D. 1891, and recorded in the office of the Register of Greene County Vol. N. W. Page 561. About nine feet of the rear of this lot are included in the Alley way and are subject to such rights as the public may have acquired therein.
