 injury thereto, and to my expense and under
 advice of Counsel, to sue for protection against
 such injury and to recover and receipt for
 any damages so received and to compound for
 any such injury which may be done lawfully
 held, or for real property, to grant bargain
 and sell, all or any of such real or personal
 property, at best price, and upon best terms
 as to him shall seem meet, and for me, and in
 my name, to make executory acknowledgments and
 deliver good and sufficient, deeds, mortgages
 and bills of sale for the same with or with-
 out covenants of warranty, to provide money upon
 the security of my real or personal property in
 such sums, as he may deem best, and to sign,
 seal, and deliver a bond or bonds for the pay-
 ment of such sum, and to sign, seal and
 deliver as security, therein a mortgage, ~~or mortgage~~
 upon said estate, with the usual power of sale
 and interest and insurance clauses and other
 usual provisions and covenants, to employ
 Counsel and pay them to attend to any legal busi-
 ness which may require the services of an
 Attorney, and in fact to do any and all such
 acts for me, and in my name concerning
 my separate estate as he may deem necessary
 and proper and as fully and sufficiently as I
 might or could do if present and acting in
 person; And whereas the said Alice Brooks,
 and desire of revoking, annulling and discon-
 tinuing said power of Attorney, now therefore
 know all men by these presents that the
 said Alice Brooks, has revoked and annulled,
 and discontinued said power of Attorney and by
 these presents do revoke, annul and discontinue
 said power of Attorney, and the said J. W.
 Brooks from this day, has no right power or
 authority to do or cause to be done any of the
 acts or things therein stated, to wit by hand
 and seal this 11th day of October A. D. 1893.
