 about two thousand dollars, the true value of the
 same will more accurately appear by an inventory
 of the same, also all of books and other accounts
 of and belonging to us in our said business at the
 said town of Burr, and in the city of Spentbury,
 which said books and other accounts will in the
 aggregate amount to about three hundred and sixty
 dollars to have and to hold the same and every part
 and portion thereof unto the said party of the second part
 his successors and assigns in trust
 however to take possession of the same and to sell
 the same with all reasonable dispatch &
 convert the same into money and also to collect
 all such debts and demands hereby assigned
 as may be collectable and with and out of the
 proceeds of sales and collections, 1st to pay and
 discharge all the just and reasonable expenses
 costs and charges of executing this assignment
 and of carrying into effect the trust hereby created
 together with a lawful commission to the party
 of the second part for his services in executing
 this trust 5th with and out of the proceeds
 of such sales and collections if there should be
 sufficient therefor the said party of the second
 part is directed to pay them to each and every
 of the creditors of the parties of the first part as well
 partners as of firm without any priority or preference
 whatsoever and if the proceeds of such sales
 and collections shall not be sufficient to pay and sat-
 isfy the debts of each and all of the creditors of
 the said partnership in full, then the said party of
 the second part is directed out of the proceeds to pay
 the said creditors ratably and in proportion to the
 amount due and owing to each of them respectively that
 is to say to each of said creditors also shall appear
 to a just dividend or dividends as they may severally
 be entitled under this deed in full satisfaction
