Whereas S. Thomas Hill, late of the County and State aforesaid, departed this life intestate on the eighth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, seized and possessed of considerable real estate in said County and State, leaving surviving him as his sole heirs at law and distributees, his widow Ellen E. Hill, and his children, Elizabeth Roe, Elsie A. McKinney and Leila J. McKinney.

And whereas on the fifteenth day of October, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, the said Ellen E. Hill, the said widow of the said S. Thomas Hill, deceased, and the said Elizabeth Roe, Elsie A. McKinney and Leila J. McKinney, children of the said S. Thomas Hill, deceased, in order to effect a division of the real estate of the said S. Thomas Hill, deceased, with litigation and expense, entered into an agreement in writing, whereby it was agreed that S. Ellen E.
