


nevertheless, to assure the rents, profits and income thereof, to the maintenance, support and education of said Squire Watt during his minority, and in trust further to convey the same to the said Squire Watt upon his coming of age. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, subject to the right of way as aforesaid, with the said Deane Watt Purvitt, his successors in office, his and their heirs against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Witness my hand and seal this 16th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety three, and in the one hundred and eighteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
