To All to Whom These Presents Shall Come,
I, Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff of Sumner County
and State aforesaid, Greeting.

Know all men by these presents, that by virtue
of a writ of *Fiis Facias* issued out of the Court
of Common Pleas, held for the County of Sumner,
viz. the 23rd day of April, in the first year of our
said one thousand eight hundred and ninety four at
the suit of R. V. Jacobs against Mallis & Gilreath
to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and
chattels, lands and tenements of Mallis & Gilreath
to wit the sum of Forty nine ⁴⁰ / 100 dollars damages
and costs, I had seized and taken of the
substance of the lands and tenements of the said Mallis
& Gilreath, viz. in part of all that certain
piece of land, containing
acres more or less, situated and being in the
County of Sumner, in the State aforesaid,
City of Sumner, on west side of Main Street,
and being lot and the now occupied by
R. V. Jacobs, and being part of the land
of the said Mallis & Gilreath, the said premises, with
this affidavit, since the seizure by me
made by virtue of the said writ of *Fiis Facias*
the said premises have been exposed to sale at public
sale, and purchased by W. B. Travis of the County of
Sumner, in the State of South Carolina for the
sum of one hundred dollars, being the highest
sum that was bid for the same, and know ye
that I, Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff aforesaid,
by virtue of said writ of *Fiis Facias* aforesaid
to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by
virtue of the Statute in that behalf made & pro-
vided, and for and in consideration of the said sum
of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid, or
to be paid, by the said W. B. Travis, the
receipt and payment whereof I do here by aforesaid
copy, have granted, bargained and sold, and by
these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto
the said W. B. Travis, his heirs and assigns forever
the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with
