Bradley of Munroe Co. party of the first part
and Gentry Finer of Ridgewood Fairfield County
party of the second part, on this the 3rd day of May 1894.
Gentry Finer was the party of the first part. He this
day assigned the party of the second part sole agent
of his Patent No 4071, known as the Bradley Sew-
ing and Dressing and Hoopener for the United
States of America, including the States of North
and South Carolina with the right to sell, make
the said machine or device to sell the whole Patent
excepting the States of North and South Carolina, or by
States or State or Counties or County, or to appoint suitable
persons to act as Agents to sell, form rights and
sell said machine or device in this respect
to make deeds of Conveyance where said Patent
is sold, and the party of the first part was
made and signed the said Deeds for seven
years from the date of Patent No 4071 from
any person or persons claiming the same or any part
thereof. The party of the second part agrees to
sell made the Sewing Dressing and Hoopener
by model furnished by the party of the first part
