To all whom these presents shall come: I, Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff of Greenville County, and State aforesaid, send Greeting:

Whereas, by writte of a certain writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, dated the ninth day of ~~October~~ August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and _____ at the suit of Thomas J. Sullivan as Executor of the last will and testament of Francis A. Gordy, deceased, against Joseph P. Latimer and John W. Latimer as Executors of the last will and testament of Hewlett Sullivan, deceased, to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and Chattels, lands and tenements of the estate of Hewlett Sullivan, deceased, to levy the sum of six thousand seven hundred and fifty seven ⁵⁷/₁₀₀ dollars, passages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said estate of Hewlett Sullivan all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing two hundred & thirty (230) acres, more or less, situate and being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in Queen's Township, adjoining lands of W. D. Latimer, R. B. Arnold and others and known as the Pinson tract.

And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by writte of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale as public vendue, and purchased by W. J. Haynesworth, of the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for the sum of one thousand ten dollars, being the highest sum that was bidden therefor:

Now, know ye, that I, Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff aforesaid, by writte of said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by writte of the Statute in such case made and provided, and found in consideration of the said sum of one thousand and ten dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid, by the said W. J. Haynesworth, the receipts and payments whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said W. J. Haynesworth, his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title and interest which the said Hewlett Sullivan of right had of, in and to the same. To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances, unto the said W. J. Haynesworth, his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely, as if the said Perry D. Gilreath, might, could or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by writte of the Statute aforesaid, and the said writ of Fieri Facias, or otherwise.
