Watson, his heirs and assigns, all her interest and estate, and also all her right and claim of Dower of, in, or to all and singular the Premises within mentioned and released in a certain deed from King Warren to J. M. Watson, and recorded in Book R.R., Page 340 of R. M. C. office, and bearing date Dec. 16th, 1894.

Know all men by these presents: That I, John H. Trammell, being the owner of the fee in and to a certain tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, about (17) sections miles from the City of Greenville, S. C., beginning at a stone about 20 feet from the N.W. corner of Distillery Building and running thence S. 59 N. 188 feet to a dogwood 3x, thence S. 53 1/2 E. 165 feet to a small oak 3x, thence N. 60 E. 156 feet to a stone, thence N. 57 N. 132 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, containing 64/100 sixty-four one-hundredths of an acre, more or less, bounded on all sides by lands of John H. Trammell. And I do hereby consent the said premises may be used by John P. Collins for the purpose of distilling spirits for the period of five years from 1 Oct., 1894, subject to the jurisdiction of law. And I do hereby stipulate and agree the Lien of the United States for penalties and taxes shall have priority of any rights, title and interest in said tract of land or any claim in my behalf, and that in case of forfeiture of said premises or any part thereof the title to same shall vest in the United States, discharged from all my title, interest or any claim in my behalf.
