Know all men by these presents I, Eliza Crain, for and in consideration of Ninety six dollars paid me by the said Ann Dill, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledge, I have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Ann Dill and her heirs and assigns all my part or interest in the tract of land deeded to me by J. J. Douthett, Probate Judge of Greenville County 23 day May 1874, and being in the State and County aforesaid, on waters of Sink hole fork of Tige river, adjoining lands of B. Ervine and others beginning at a stake on said river thence N 5 E 450 to a stone 3x7 in a path thence N 83 1/2 W. 875 to a stone 3x0 on the Branch thence down the said branch to the river, thence down said river to the beginning corner and containing Twenty four 24 acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land, belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold. And I Eliza Crain do hereby bind myself my heirs executors or administrators or assigns to forever warrant and defend the same against myself my heirs executors administrators or assigns and against all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof unto the said Ann Dill.
