Know all men by these presents, that the City Council of Greenville in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars, to it in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by W. S. Wood (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, quit, conveyed, and released unto the said W. S. Wood, \$20.00 of the improved Cemetery, having the following dimensions, to wit: A strip of land by fifteen feet wide for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purposes aforesaid and subject to the conditions of the right character of said grant, and all provisions thereof, and amendments that may be made hereof, and also subject to the Ordinance of said City & the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committees now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein. To gether with all and singular the rights, tenements and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold and all singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said W. S. Wood his heirs and assigns forever, subject however to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed, and he do hereby bind himself and his successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. S. Wood, his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors in office, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness the seal of said City Council of Greenville, this 31st day of October 1894, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety four, and in the 119th year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
