I, Perry D. Sibbath, Sheriff of Greenville County, and  
State aforesaid, send Greetings:

Whereas by virtue of writ of  
Fieri Facias issued, out of the Court of Common Pleas,  
held for the County of Greenville, at the 15th day of
