I, Henry C. Gilbreath, Sheriff of Greenville County and State aforesaid, send Declining:

Whereas by virtue of a writ
of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas,
held for the County of Greenville, lasted the 26th day of
August in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight
hundred and Ninety three, at the suit of Thos. J. Sullivan
and Executor of the Last Will and Testament of Franklin W. Good,
gives due & present Joseph P. Latimer & H. Latimer Esqrs
of the last Will and Testament of Franklin Sullivan and Good.
Complaint, commanding me that of the goods and chattels
lands and tenements of Jas. P. Latimer and John H. Latimer
Esqrs, totaling the sum of Sixty One hundred and
and fifty seven $\frac{5}{8}$ Dollars, damages and costs, I have
seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Jas.

provided, and for and in consideration of the sum of
Five hundred Dollars to me paid, or secured
to be paid, by the said B. M. McGee, the receipt and pay-
ment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted
bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bar-
gain and sell unto the said B. M. McGee his heirs and
assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land
with its appurtenances and all of the estate, right title and
interest which the said Jas. P. Latimer and John H. Latimer
as Execs of right had or ought to the same to have and
to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with
