 Grove Methodist Episcopal Church of Piedmont, County of  
 Greenville, State of South Carolina of the second part;

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for  
 and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars,  
 lawful money of the United States of America, to said first party  
 well and truly paid by Henry Kirksey, Thos. Fraser and  
 Geo. W. Williams Trustees as of or said party of the second  
 part, at and before the executing and delivery of these presents  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted  
 bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant  
 bargain sell and convey unto said party of the second part  
 their successors and assigns all that tract and parcel of  
 land situate in Greenville County of South Carolina  
 State of, described as follows, to wit: - A certain lot of  
 land situate lying and being in the State and County  
 aforesaid in Grove township near Piedmont Factory  
 joining lands of C. D. Nesbitt containing two acres  
 more or less, and has the following metes and bounds  
 commencing at a stone 3+ thence N 76° W 4.50 to a stone 3+  
 thence N 10° W 4.50 to a stone 3+ thence S 76° E 4.50 to a stone, thence  
 S 10° E 4.50 to the beginning corner. †
