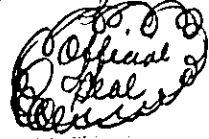

Blair (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lewis H. Blair, all the late interest of Ella J. Charles in and to that certain tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of John C. Charles, William Pepper, and others and containing two hundred and three acres, more or less, a full description of said tract of land will appear by reference to a deed of conveyance from G. W. French to the said Ella J. Charles of date the seventh day of March 1879, and recorded in book J. J. page 489, in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for said County, and also all that tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of William A. Pepper, A. C. McEee and others, and containing one hundred and eighteen acres, more or less, a more particular description on said tract of land can be had by reference to a deed of conveyance of the same from G.
