

(7) Also that other lot in said County, town and State, known as lot No 4 on McAlhany St. being the lot whereon is situated the ginhouse formerly, belonging to the said Company, having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a stone of McAlhany St near the cotton scales above referred to, thence S 39 $\frac{3}{4}$  W 87 ft. to a stone at corner of J D Coopers property, thence N 50 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 105 ft. to stone near graveyard, thence N 39 $\frac{3}{4}$  E 87 ft. to a stone at corner of Coopers land, thence S 50 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 105 ft. to beginning corner. Also the following machinery situate on said premises to wit: 1 steam engine of horse power of Eclipse make, 2 gins 50 and 40 saws respectively of Pratt make, 1 seed crusher, 1 cotton press, and all belting pulleys and shafting used and connected with such engine gins and crusher.

(8) Also that other lot in said town, county and State, situate on McAlhany St. whereon is situated the stable of said Company, said lot containing one half acre, more or less.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appurtenant; and all the estate right title claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and each of them, in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from under or by these or any of them.

To Have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said National Bank of Greenville S.C. its successors and assigns forever.
