lina approved December 24<sup>th</sup> 1890 the Trustees

empowered to sell and convey in fee simple  
to any person who shall purchase all or any  
portion of the lands left by the last will and  
testament of Thomas Trademont deceased  
for the support of a poor school in Currituck  
County, if in their judgment it will be  
best for the interest of said school, and  
whereas it has been determined by said  
Trustees that it will be best for the interest  
of said school, that the lands hereinafter de-  
scribed be sold and the said lands being a  
portion of the land left by the last will  
and testament of Thomas Trademont  
deceased for the support of a poor school  
in Currituck County. Now therefore know  
all men by these presents that we, M. M. Taylor  
W. P. Turner R. J. Colcland and P. C. Davis  
Trustees of the Trustees Poor School of Currituck  
County in the State aforesaid for and in  
consideration of the sum of one hundred and  
eighty dollars to us in hand paid at and  
before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged  
have granted conveyed sold and released, and  
by these presents do grant convey sell and
