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Know all men by these Presents, that whereas on the 14th day of November, 1895 a certain agreement was entered into by and between Joseph P. Lattimer of the County and State aforesaid and J. R. Hill of said County and State, whereby the said Joseph P. Lattimer give unto the said J. R. Hill an option to purchase the premises hereinafter described upon the terms and conditions set forth in the instrument at the price of \$17,000 and whereas the said J. R. Hill has agreed and do hereby agree to purchase the said premises at the said price and according to the terms and conditions of said instrument, reference to which is hereby made; that is to say, the said J. R. Hill is to pay three thousand dollars cash and the remainder in annual installments of three thousand dollars each for four years and two thousand dollars the fifth year, said credit portion to bear interest at seven per cent per annum, and the interest upon each installment to be paid when
