the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents DO
GRANT, bargain, sell, and release unto the said

Amie B. Walker all that tract and
parcel of land, situate lying and being in the County and State
aforesaid, on the banks of the River of South River, containing
the first thirty six acres more or less it being the right side
of the River and on which he died at the time of his death
the tract having originally been part of his farm, to be bounded
as follows: Beginning on a *1/2* A.C. on the road leading to
Amie B. Walker, and thence *N. 43/4 W. 10.50* to a *1/2* A.C. *8.85*
