the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents DO  
GRANT, bargain, sell, and release unto the said

*Henry Ware*, all that piece, parcel or tract of  
land situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the east side of the *White*  
*Horse Road*, containing *twenty* acres, more or less, the same having been conveyed by to  
*Richard Alexander* in two separate tracts of ten acres each by separate deeds from  
*A. L. Cobb*, said deeds being recorded in the office of the Register of *Deeds* for the County  
for said County in Book *C.O. pages 144 & 143*, and therein more particularly described.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim, and interest whatsoever, of the  
parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them, in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from,  
under, or by these or any of them.
