the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents DO  
GRANT, bargain, sell, and release unto the said C. H. Judson as Treasurer of Furman  
University, all that piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being partly  
in the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville  
and State of South Carolina, and known as the Rev. Samuel M. Green's mill place  
having the following miles and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone corner on  
the N. side of the Laurens Road, Mrs. Henderson's & said S. M. Green's corner; thence  
with said road to the junction of the Spartanburg and Laurens roads, thence  
with the center of the Spartanburg road 9.45 chs to a stone opposite a wild cherry  
N m; thence S 8° E 8.70 to a B. Green's m; thence N 7° E 4.4 chs, to a stake & near a branchy  
thence with the meanderings of branch as raised by a ten foot dam on the north
