in the State aforesaid, about one mile out of the City of Greenville, on both sides of the Air Line Rail Road and  
on a branch of the Long Branch of Reedy River, containing thirty acres, more or less; Beginning at  
a stake on the Road on the Double line, running thence N. 18° W. 16.00 to stake 3 x 0.00, thence N. 55° W. 21.00 to  
stake 3 x 0.00, thence S. 20° E. 28.00 to stake 3 x 0.00 in the road, thence to stake 3 x 0.00 in the road on the  
Double line 12.60 as per plat of J. H. Southern, D. S., dated March 10th, 1884. Said tract being  
bounded by lands of Mrs. Matie Gilbreath - Eastwood; by land of Baum - Northward; by land of  
J. A. Horow, westward and by the Piedens Road southward. Subject however to the Right of Way of the
