(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said J. H. O'Neal all that said tract or lot of land situated lying
and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid. Beginning at a stake
on the New Cut Road thence N 40° W 24.87 to a stake thence, D 85° 14' E 37.50
to a stake, thence D 13° E 23.16 to a stake on said Road, thence with said
Road S 83° 40' 3.00 to the beginning corner, containing Twenty-Two acres
a half acres more or less. And known as Lot no 46 in the division of the
Real Estate of John Westfield, deceased and bounded by lands of Miss
Morgan, Dickey and Lot no 45 of said Survey.
