 Greenville County, and State aforesaid, on both sides of Lamp Creek a  
 branch of South Tyger River, Beginning at a white Oak 34' 3" 34' and running  
 thence N 34 E 27, 37 to a stone 34, thence S 85 E 5' 0" to a stone 34 by a Post Oak,  
 thence N 15 E 31, 5" to a stone 34 n, thence N 44 W 9, 60 to a stone 34, thence S 58 W  
 11, 20 to a stone 34, thence N 12 W 23, 15 to an Ash 34, thence south 7, 0" to a stone 34  
 thence S 64 W 34, 65 to a stone 34 n, thence S 18 E 10, 00 a stone 34 n, thence
