Watson, all that certain piece of land and tract of land containing One-hundred and one acres, more or less, situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on both sides of the Gap Creek Road, adjoining lands of William West, Albert Calhoun and others, and being a part of what is known as the Bates tract, Beginning on a Spanish Oak on a road, and running thence N 11 1/8 E 35.53 rods, to a rock 34, thence N 52 W 19.60 rods, to a Chestnut 34 rods, thence S 15 W 3.33 rods, to a white Oak 34 rods, thence S 27 1/4 W 35.07 rods, to a stone 34 rods, across the Gap Creek Road thence with said road as a line to a stone 34 rods, on the south side, thence S 22 1/2 W 5.00 rods, to a stone 34 rods, thence S 07 E 18.50 rods, to a stone on a road, thence N 17 1/2 E with said road, to the beginning corner, on the Spanish Oak,
