All that tract piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina known and described as follows to wit; Beginning at a stake near Bush Creek, and running thence S 61° 00' 00" W to a stake 34, thence S 34° 00' 30" W to a Spanish Oak 34, thence 32° 00' 00" W to a stake 31, thence 80° 00' 30" W to a Red Oak 34, thence S 37° 00' 00" W to a stake thence N 51° 00' 00" W to a small pine, thence N 41° 00' 00" W to a Poplar 34, thence along with the meandering of said Bush Creek to a White Oak 34, thence N 60° 00' 00" W to a poplar 34, thence N 43° 00' 00" W to the beginning, containing Twenty three acres and one half acres, and bounded by lands of G. W. Townes, R. A. Townes and Adam Snyder. Said land hereby conveyed being the same conveyed by George W. Townes and R.
