 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
 release unto the said Thomas E. Watson all my right, title and interest  
 The same being one undivided one half interest in or to all  
 and singular, that certain piece parcel & tract of land, containing  
 Eighty & one half acres more or less situate lying and being in  
 Bates Township in the County & State aforesaid on both sides  
 of the Gof Creek road and having the following metes and bounds  
 to wit: Beginning at a sp. oak 3x0m on a road and running  
 Thence N $11\frac{1}{2}$  E 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ .45 crossing the Gof Creek Road to a stone 3x0m  
 S. L. Montgomery corner, thence with said Montgomery's N 48. W 4.30  
 to a stone 3x0m thence N 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 10.18 to a hickory 3x0m thence  
 N. 17 E 5.70 to stone 3x0m, thence N 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 10.18 to a large white  
 oak 3x0m Mrs Dill & Florence Hatton's corner thence S 29 $\frac{1}{2}$  W.
