and released, and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said D.D. Davenport
all of that certain piece parcel and lot of land
situate lying and being in Greenville County in
State aforesaid being a portion of a tract of land
conveyed to G.R. Morrow by J.W. Cunningham
on 8th day of May 1863, and recorded in R.M.C.
office eight day of March 1874, in Book D.D. Page
1169, and known as lot # 10 in a survey made by
A.R. Wood on May 6th 1897, and has the following
courses, metes and bounds to wit: - Beginning at
a stake in center of Chick Springs road 4 1/2 miles thence
N 7 1/2 E 3.16 chs to stone N.M. W.E. Morrow's corner
thence S 58 1/2 E 3.16 chs to a stone N.M. M.E. Hawkins
corner thence S 7 1/2 W 3.16 chs to center Chick Springs
road M.E. Hawkins corner thence N 58 1/2 W 3.16
chs to beginning & contains one acre more or
less bounded by lots # 2 & 3 & the Chick Springs Road,
