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Charter  
 The State of South Carolina  
 By the Secretary of State,  
 Whereas J. F. Hunt of Greenville S.C.  
 W. D. Ebaugh  
 W. A. Adams  
 G. W. Ebaugh  
 did on the 29th day of July 1898, file with the  
 Secretary of State a written Declaration signed  
 by themselves, setting forth:  
 First: The names and residences of the said  
 petitioners to be as above given;  
 Second: The purpose of the proposed corporation  
 to be that of "Mountain City Milling Company"  
 The principal place of business will be Greenville S.C.  
 The general purpose of the corporation and the  
 nature of business it purposes to do, is to buy  
 and sell wheat, corn and other grain and all  
 products thereof, to grind the said grain into  
 flour, meal, grits and other products, to erect  
 equip and maintain flour and grits mills at  
 Greenville and other points in this State to buy  
 sell manipulate and manufacture fertilizers  
 of all kinds, and to sell the same on commission  
 or otherwise, to give cotton and build and run  
 graineries throughout the state, to buy and sell  
 cotton seed and cotton seed meal, to erect and  
 maintain mills for the manufacture of cotton  
 seed into oil and sell the products thereof  
 Third: The amount of Capital Stock to be  
 fifty thousand Dollars and the number  
 of shares into which the same is to be divided  
 to be three hundred of the par value one hundred  
 Dollars each  
 And whereas the said

the said above named petitioners were commissioned  
 by me a Board of Corporators, authorizing and empow-  
 ering them to open books of subscription to the Capital  
 Stock of said proposed corporation, giving not less  
 than one days notice by advertisement in a news-
