vs. H. C. Moore

The State of South Carolina
County of Laurens
Whereas, under the act of the Legislature
of the State of South Carolina, approved
December 24th 1890, the Trustees of the
Madamworth Poor School, and their suc-
cessors in office are authorized and
empowered to sell and convey in fee
simple, to any person who shall pur-
chase all of any portion of the lands
left by the last will and testament of
Thomas Madamworth, deceased, for the sup-
port of a poor school in Laurens County,
if in their judgment it will be best for
the interests of said school;

And whereas it has been determined by
said Trustees that it will be best for the
interest of said school that the lands here-
inafter described be sold, and the said
lands being a portion of the land left
by the last will and testament of Thomas
Madamworth, deceased, for the support of
a poor school in Laurens County.

Now, know all men by these Presents
that we, William Wright - M. M. League,
N. P. Turner, R. J. Copeland and R. C. Lewis
Trustees of the Madamworth Poor School
of Laurens County, in the State aforesaid,
for and in consideration of the sum of
Twenty five Dollars, to us in hand paid
at Cash before the making and delivery
of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargain-
ed, sold and delivered, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell, and
warrant unto H. C. Moore, his heirs, and
assigns forever, all that certain parcel
or lot of land, situate lying and being
in the County of Laurens, State of South
Carolina, and containing more or less than

half an acre, more or less, and half such
marks, bounds &c as follows by Begin-
ing on a stone on H. C. Moore's land, thence
along his line S 58 W 3.30 to a stone thence
S 7 E 9.48 to a stone thence N 63 E 7.00
to a stake thence N 29 W 9.40 to the be-
ginning corner. Bounded by lands of
H. C. Moore, E. Simmons, F. J. Clyde, and
A. B. Lewis
together with all and singular the Rights
Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenan-
ces to the said premises belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining.
To Have and To Hold, full and singu-
lar the said premises hereunto
unto the said H. C. Moore his heirs, and
assigns forever
And we do hereby bind ourselves and
our successors and assigns, to war-
rant and forever defend full and singu-
lar the said premises unto the said
H. C. Moore his heirs and assigns,
against us and our successors and
assigns and the heirs and assigns
of Thomas Madamworth, deceased, law-
fully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof
