 County of Stoddard } Know all men by these presents, that I William Croft of the County and State aforesaid have nominated constituted and appointed and by these presents do nominate constitute and appoint Wilson Croft of Greenville County and State of South Carolina my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name place and stead to sell transfer and convey all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being on Richardson and Coffee Streets in the City and County of Greenville State of South Carolina and having the following meter and bounds viz: - Beginning at the N.E. corner of the Presbyterian Church lot on Richardson St. and runs 149 feet to a stake on Dickrons line, thence with Dickrons line 151 feet to a stake in Coffee Street, thence with Coffee Street 28 feet to Howells corner, thence with Howells line 53 1/2 feet to a stake on Howells back line, thence with the line of said Howells lot 121 feet to a stake on Richardson Street thence with Richardson Street 90 feet to the beginning, containing one third of an acre, more or less, adjoining lots of the Presbyterian Church, Howells, Dickron and others, and known as the Margaret Walker lot, and I do hereby authorize my said attorney to sign any paper or papers of whatsoever nature, whether under seal or not and generally to do whatsoever else may be necessary and requisite in the premises as fully and perfectly as I myself could do if personally present. And I do hereby ratify and confirm against myself, my heirs executors and administrators what so ever my said attorney may lawfully do in the premises, witness my hand and seal this first day of January A.D. 1879.
