Know all men by these presents: That we Ida M. Roberts of Greenville - Annie Roberts Adkins of Greenville County S.C. and Kate Roberts Collins of Henderson County N.C. and Eva L. David of the City and County of Greenville heirs of Annie Judson Roberts deceased in the City State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mary E. Bellotte of the City of Greenville and County of Greenville (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary E. Bellotte, all that piece parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the City and County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina on Denmark St. of said City beginning at a Post Oak on Denmark Street in the City of Greenville

thence and twenty four feet to a stake, thence in a westerly direction thirty (30) feet to a stake in line of lot owned by William. Thence along east mentioned lot in a southwardly direction Forty Hundred and ten feet to the Denmark Street, Thence along said street with the fence on said street One hundred and one feet - to the beginning Post at Post Oak, being the same lot known as the Residence of the late Mrs. Annie Judson Roberts and indicated by fence or line of said lot and bounded by lands of Marshall, Killbuck and Denmark Street, being the same lot conveyed by Martha A. Hartstein Executrix of the estate of Mrs. Florence H. Davis deceased of New York to Mrs. Annie Judson Roberts by deed dated 15th day of May 1884 and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County Vol. N. K. Page 477.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular, the said premises unto the said Mary E. Bellotte - her heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary E. Bellotte, her heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
