and others, beginning at a corner with Johnson &
Gordons Corner west side of the new Gap Creek road
Running north to a stone corner on the north line
of the Edwards survey on the Gam Mountain, thence
with the Edwards old N. E. and S. E. line to J. F. Morgans
line, thence with J. F. Morgans line to a chestnut
corner near a spring on the old Gap Creek road,
thence with the old Gap Creek road to the State
line rock on the new Gap Creek road, thence with
the new Gap Creek road to the beginning corner
Containing 50 acres more or less, together with
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises, to belong
or in anywise incident or appertaining, to be had
