receipt where of is hereby acknowledged) have granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
Paris Mountain water Company The right to take
water from the streams which furnish power to the
mill owned by Joseph Brookshire and Quintus A
Green for the purpose of furnishing the City of Greenville
and the inhabitants thereof with water which was
granted to the said The American Pipe Manufacturing
Company by Joseph Brookshire and Quintus A Green
on January 24th 1891, and recorded in Deed Book
W. D. page 484, A. B. by 14th 1891.

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said
premises before mentioned unto the said Paris
Mountain water Company its successors and assigns
forever. And The American Pipe Manufacturing
Company does hereby bind itself its successors and
assigns to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said Paris
Mountain water Company its successors and assigns
against it and its successors and assigns and
every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof.
