Know all men by these presents, That we Hannah J Cox, Mary E Cox of the County of Jackson Louise S Lammear of the County of Wake all of the State of aforesaid by our attorney in fact and Thos A Cox of State of County first aforesaid, being the only heirs at law Distributors of St John Cox dec'd for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) dollars to us in hand paid at & before the sealing of these presents by William Fisher of the County of Greenville State of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Wm Fisher, all that certain piece parcel or lot of land in the South Ward of the City of Greenville County of Greenville State of South Carolina, being Lot No 10 of Block No. 1, of a subdivision of Lands bounded by Houstonia Lewis Plum Streets & the Columbia & Greenville R.R. to be more particularly described hereafter.

The above described land being a part of a tract of land having been conveyed by deed from Mary E Cox to St John Cox bearing date of May 26th 1886, & being recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance of Greenville S.C. in Book R B page 846.

Whereas Hugh M Barton of Chick Spring, W E Cox of Lenderman, W A Hamby of Mauldin, S H McRae of Greenville, all of the County of Greenville South Carolina and C N Carpenter of Biggs P. O. in the County of Pickens and State aforesaid did on the Eleventh day of April 1900 file with the Secretary of State a certain Declaration
