Babb, being the owner of the fee premises by any mortgage, judgment or any other lien of a certain tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the new cut Road in Butler Township about Two and one half 1/2 miles from Greenville Court House containing one fourth of an acre, more or less, and having the following meter and bounds, viz: - Beginning on a rock Twenty (20) feet from S. E. Cor. of Stile house, running thence S 54 feet to a Willow Bush, thence East 32 feet to an Iron Pin, thence North 50 feet to an Iron Pin, thence N.
