and State aforesaid, in Grove Township, having following metes and bounds to wit:  
Beginning at a post oak, and running thence N. 30° 30' W. 20.70 chains to a stone  
(formerly a pine) thence N. 33½ W. of S. 30° 30' ch. to a dogwood on the creek, thence  
S. 61° W. 9.50 ch. to a stone; thence N. 39 3/4 W. 14.36 ch. to a stone; thence  
N. 67° W. 36.30 ch. to a stone; thence S. 35° 30' 21.00 ch. to beginning, containing  
one hundred (100) acres more or less, and bounded by lands of David Terry,  
Julia Davis, Miller West and William Pearson, being same tract conveyed to  
me by my father Garrett Bergin, by deed bearing date November 27, 1879 and
