Now Therefore, I, M. R. Cooper, Secretary of State, by virtue of authority in me vested do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities conferred by an Act of the General Assembly of South Carolina, entitled "An Act to provide for the incorporation of Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal or Charitable Churches, Societies, Associations or Companies, and for amending the Charters of those already formed," approved February 19, A. D. 1900, and other provisions of law.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State at Columbia, this 17th December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and in the one hundred and twenty-fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.

Ridgeway for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Thirty-two Dollars to us each paid in a tract of land by Matthie Traynham, have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Matthie Traynham, All that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid containing twenty-four acres, more or less, Beginning on stone No. 1, b. Traynham's line, Thence S. 80 E. 24. 74 to Stone, Thence N. 20 1/2 E. 1. 74 dogwood, Thence N. 27 1/2 W. 3. 37, Thence N. 1 1/2 E. 2. 45 to stone, Thence N. 26 3/4 W. 4. 36 to stone, Thence S. 32 1/2 W. 1. 23 to stake, Thence N. 5 1/2 W. 2. 70 to stone, Thence N. 12. W. 2. 68 to stone, N. 61 W. 1. 23 to cedar, Thence N. 82 1/4 W. 2. 50 to stone, Thence S. 79 W. 2. 13 to Hickory, Thence S. 60 W. 4. 10 to Red Oak, Thence N. 68 W. 2. 37 to N. O. Stump, Thence N. 43 W. 1. 50 to stone, Thence S. 63 W. 7. 06 to stone, Thence S. 5 E. 6. 70 to beginning bounded by lands of Mrs M. C.
