Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, by virtue of the authority to him given, in and by the said last Will and Testament, and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to A. O. Davis, by the said party of the second part, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part, her Heirs and Assigns forever, all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, both in law and equity, which the said Testator had at the time of his decease; and which the said party of the first part has by virtue of the said last Will and Testament of Warren Priestly, Sr, of in and to all that certain piece, parcel or Plot of Land, situate in the said County; to wit: -

Beginning at a stake at a corner and running N. 9. 80 (to corner, (pine) 3x n. thence west 5. 50 to a corner, (stone) 3x, thence West to a stone 3x n. east, to the beginning corner, containing five acres, more or less, known as Lot 16 on a plat surveyed by H.
